

Innovative Best Practices to Prevent Truck & Bus Crashes

On November 13-14, 2024, the University of Massachusetts Traffic Safety Research Program (UMassSafe), with support from the FMCSA, hosted the Northeast Commercial Vehicle Safety Summit: Innovative Best Practices to Prevent Truck & Bus Crashes. The Summit brought together 140 attendees from 57 agencies and organizations involved in truck and bus safety to share best practices, demonstrate innovative programming and technologies, and establish and strengthen partnerships to prevent commercial vehicle crashes.


Following the Summit, UMassSafe solicited feedback using a survey sent to all attendees, in order to improve future Summits and programming. Of the 140 attendees, 64 responded. 98% of respondents indicated their experience was excellent/good, while 2% indicated their experience was adequate, and no respondents indicated their experience was poor. Respondents indicated at least 92% satisfaction (excellent/good) with plenary panels and concurrent sessions.

Overall, how would you rate your experience at the Summit?




■ Excellent ■ Good ■ Adequate ■ Poor


Please rate your level of satisfaction with the following Summit elements.
